

# SA is safe from baby food scare

FEARS spread like wildfire when people read messages on Facebook that Nestlé baby food contains pieces of glass!

And concerns grew when the same message was read on a local community radio station.

The message said: "Important alert for all parents – Nestlé is asking everyone to return all banana baby food expiring in 2012. They may contain pieces of glass. Barcode 761303308973.

But Nestlé's local spokesman, Motshidisi Mokwena, told *Daily Sun* that the products mentioned are not even available in South Africa. This incident only happened in France.

"This recall has no impact on any Nestlé baby food products made for the South African market," said Mokwena.
